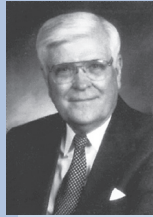

Churches must not permit themselves to get bogged down in earthly things that prevent them from preaching the eternal word of God out where people can hear it.

## UNITY AMONG BRETHREN

We began writing about unity in the body of Christ when the news came that the two churches of Christ in the small town of Wilburton, OK (pop. 3,092) worked out the issues between them and became one to the glory of Christ. First we wrote about the class system of teaching God's word. In response to a request for help we followed with a discussion of the "one cup" issue. I'm not challenging anyone for a debate on any of these issues. I'm seeking "unity" not "debates." I have been encouraged by reports of renewed efforts toward unity on such matters as classes and cups.

SEARCH recently received a telephone call from a church of four members in a distant state. They requested some CDs of our programs to be used as their Sunday sermons. It had been a church of more than forty members, but they got a new preacher who persuaded the others they needed to join a revolution within the restoration movement. The others left the church to form or to join a "community-church-like" group where they would have the liberty to worship as they like. After all, doesn't Paul say, "Christ has made us free" and we should not be "entangled in a yoke of bondage" (Gal. 5:1)?

From all over the country come calls and mail repeating that story. Why will a young man go into a peaceful, loving and struggling or prospering church and divide its people by putting "his new wine in those old bottles" (Matt. 9:17)?

Jesus said to Peter and the other apostles, "I will build My church.....And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." He also gave them the Holy Spirit to guide them into "all truth" (John 14:26; 16:5-15; Acts 1:4-5). Brother, don't be deceived. Whatever those apostles *preached* or *wrote* is "inspired of God" (2 Tim. 3:16-17). It is "bound in Heaven" to this day. While New Testament churches were autonomous, they were never free to bind where the apostles did not bind or to loose as they pleased.

Elders (men of mature faith) are ordained by the Lord in every church to "watch for the souls in their charge and to protect them from such deceitful workers" (2 Cor. 11:13). They are to "feed" the flock of God (Acts 20:28) so those in their charge will be "grounded and settled" in the faith (Col. 1:23), unmoved by "wolves in sheep's clothing" (Matt. 7:15). Elders will give account to God for a divided church (1 Pet. 5:1-4).

Preachers, I beseech you, preach *the word of God!* That is our charge from God (2 Tim. 4:1-5). We are not charged

with being the savior of the church from our perceived traditions. Jesus Christ is the church's Savior. His word is still God's power to save the lost (Rom. 1:16). If you can't "preach the word," I pray you, don't divide His body, the church. It would be better to have been the soldier who pierced the Savior's side. The night before His crucifixion, being in agony, our Savior prayed for us that we might be ONE (John 17:20-23). It was important to Him that we be ONE. It should be a matter of high priority with us to be ONE!

On January 12 we were honored to have a visit from brother K.B.B. Chandrapaul from Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh, India. Brother Chandrapaul is the managing director of the Jack Nalle Institute. Since its opening in 1991, they have trained over 3,000 Gospel preachers and sent them throughout India and to other parts of the world. He is supported in part by the Southern Ridge congregation in Oklahoma City and wanted to come by and see the studio while he was in the states for a visit. Brother Willie Hamblin of Leoma, TN, who also helps support Mr. Chandrapaul, showed him our program on the website [www.searchtv.org](http://www.searchtv.org) and suggested it as an encouragement and a help to those in India studying the Word and learning the English language.

Luke says in chapter 8 that the "sower went out to sow his seed and as he sowed, some fell by the wayside, some fell on rock, and some fell among thorns, but some fell on good ground, sprang up, and yielded a crop a hundredfold." The Internet is far reaching, literally worldwide, and clearly not everyone is listening to the program. But what an encouragement it is for us to know, that in a part of the world where some men have been "trampled underfoot" for speaking the name of Jesus, the Gospel has found fertile ground, is alive and well, and Search is there also. ### MAR 29 – THE GIFT OF REPENTANCE

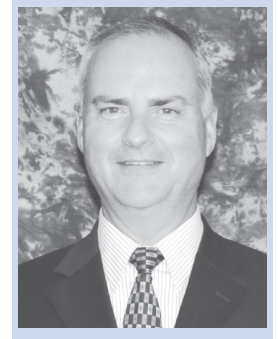
