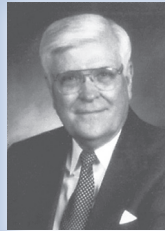

The Priesthood of All Believers

And coming to Him as to a living stone which has been rejected by men, but is choice and precious in the sight of God, you also, as living stones, are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ

(1 Pet. 2:4-5 NASB).

Under the old covenant, only the Levites could serve as priests. Priests had two functions: (1) they offered up sacrifices in worship, and (2) they were to "to teach the sons of Israel all the statutes which the LORD has spoken to them through Moses" (Lev. 10:11).

Under the new covenant, however, every Christian shares in the priesthood. Every Christian has the responsibility to worship and to teach others the unsearchable riches of Christ. "But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy" (1 Pet. 2:9-10 ESV).

There are souls all around your neighborhood that need the gospel of Jesus Christ, and God has asked every Christian to be involved in proclaiming the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. One way to reach into the home of your neighbor is to invite him to watch "In Search of the Lord's Way" every Sunday morning. Television as a media is the cheapest and most effective way to get into the homes of people who have an interest in spiritual matters.

From the beginning In Search of the Lord's Way has made a commitment to serving local churches, because we know that the church grows through the outreach of the congregation. Search can help you teach the lost. Advertise its program time in your bulletin and in the local newspaper. Give your members cards and pamphlets that tell of the program to give their neighbors.

When you help In Search of the Lord's Way by your prayers, your invitations to neighbors, and your contributions, you are sharing in the great task of proclaiming the excellencies of him who called us out of darkness into his marvelous light. That's why we need your help.

THE FIELDS ARE WHITE!

Are'n't we thankful for the missionary zeal of so many churches of Christ! I receive innumerable church bulletins and I read them. I just finished reading the ones that came in yesterday's mail along with two publications of world-wide ministries. Virtually every one of them reported involvement in "mission" efforts somewhere in Asia, Africa, Australia, Europe, South America or some of the islands of the seas. Let us encourage and support and pray for all of them who are sacrificially and faithfully preaching the soul-saving gospel of Christ. I am serious about this, friend: who can tell when the matured fruits of their labors will be sending missionaries to our own beloved country? It could be much sooner than we think! Some faithful missionaries are training them now.

Postmodern American Style religion has made a "joke" (an unbeliever's word)—of Christianity. It rejects the "one God and Father of all" (Eph. 4:6) as "doctrinally exclusive and unacceptable." Under the banner of "Christianity" it contemptuously celebrates Darwin's theory of evolution. It accepts the gods of Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism and other false religions. It has its own self-made gods: "the god of my liking," "the god of my prosperity," "the god of my health," etc. In Old Testament history when God's people accepted the pagan gods of other nations, God permitted them to be conquered by them and become their slaves.

America is said to be the THIRD largest mission field in today's world. With American Christians the United States should be of FIRST concern and interest. The spirit of Postmodern American Style religion is a failure. It has "sold out" to the "gods of acceptance." Therefore, it falls heavily on the churches of Christ to get "the gospel of God" (Rom. 1:1) to THE PEOPLE OF AMERICA!

That's what SEARCH is doing! If the truth could be known, Phil Sanders and I are preaching the gospel by television to more people in ANY TOWN OR CITY in the U.S than the church in that town is. SEARCH is reported by those whose business it is to know, to be among the top three religious programs in American TV. We need your help! We desperately need your help! Let us hear from you today! 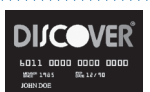
I would ask him to study the Upon the Rock Bible Study with me. I would keep praying for my friend and not stop. I would keep working with him after he became a Christian.

May 3 – WHAT IF HELL IS REAL

Three of ten Americans think there is no such place as hell. Some think they will cease to exist when they die, and others think they will be reincarnated. One in four Americans have “no idea” what will happen to them when they die. But, what if hell is real? Would its reality make any difference in our lives?

May 10 –THE GOD WHO UNDERSTANDS

Some folks think of God as so stuck off in heaven He doesn’t understand what is happening in our lives, but is that true? The Bible presents a very different picture of God as one who is intimately acquainted with every person and wanting to help His children through every struggle and trial of life.

May 17 – “THERE IS ONE BAPTISM”

The Holy Spirit wrote in Ephesians 4:1-6: “There is one baptism.” Yet, the Bible mentions “the baptism of the Holy Spirit,” “the baptism of John,” “the baptism in water,” etc. Which of these, if any, is that “one baptism” of Ephesians 4:1-6?

May 24 – THE JOY OF SALVATION

When David, 2nd king of Israel, had lost it in his sin with Bathsheba, he prayed to God, “Restore to me the joy of Your salvation.” There is no greater joy than in the salvation of the Lord. Have you lost it? We pray it will be restored to you. Let’s study about that, what do you say?

May 31 – WALKING IN THE SPIRIT

The Bible instructs Christians to walk in the Spirit, but what does that mean? Does that mean the Spirit will personally and directly guide our every step? Or could walking with the Spirit mean we are led by the Spirit through the teaching of the Word of God?

SPOTLIGHT

While attending the Faulkner University Lectureship March 2-5, I had the privilege to talk with hundreds of Christians who visited the SEARCH display. During this time I was also able to have conversations with individuals who were representing other ministries at their displays. As I talked with David Howell, who works with the television ministry “Getting To Know Your Bible” of Summerdale, AL, he asked if SEARCH ever had problems with follow-up workers. These are Christians who would be ready and willing to study the Bible with people in their town when a request was made. David and his wife went on to tell of many difficulties they had encountered with this effort. And, I had to admit SEARCH also runs into this problem at times.

As David and I continued to discuss this issue I told him I would write my next SEARCH newsletter article on this subject and work on developing a method to address this problem. Honestly, much of the time when we call a church looking for someone to study with people, either an elder

or preacher will accommodate the need very quickly. But, there are

instances when, after calling three or four churches in xyz, USA, no one answers the initial call, and to make matters worse, never calls us back. I know you are thinking how can this be, but it is true, friends, more than you can possibly imagine.

The SEARCH staff is considering building a database by state with the names and contact information of Christians who would volunteer to be a go-to person for these one-on-one Bible studies.
