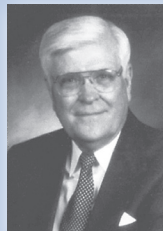

From all over the nation come personal one-time contributions to help us in these difficult times to maintain our preaching on **television, radio, the printed page and by internet and satellite to the world!**

Many of the checks are accompanied by apologies for being in such small amounts; but every one, regardless of the amount, is sincerely appreciated and is an expression of commitment to preaching the gospel. Others are for much larger amounts. All are according to ability, I am sure.

We have always tried to use as much as 90 cents of every dollar sent to us for what it was given for (to preach the word). We have sometimes reached as much as 92 cents, leaving only 8 cents for salaries, utilities, insurance, etc. However, in these times of economic stress, when support has dropped off, we have been unable to do that. Our goal is to get back to as much as 92 cents. Every regular contributor to SEARCH receives a detailed monthly financial report.

A few churches, seeing our distress, have done like the one whose letter I read this morning. It said, "Several years ago our congregation sent a monthly contribution to In Search. It was later discontinued in favor of a couple of other mission programs. I am happy to report that the brethren once again have agreed to start sending a monthly contribution to your good work."

Another said they had "had a special missions contribution. The attached check represents the total contributed."

I was in local ministry for half a century and I know it takes awhile for a group—a missions committee, the elders, the members to get together and agree to support SEARCH, so I am still anticipating more such mail from churches.

IT WORKS!

"For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven and do not return there but water the earth, making it bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it" (Isaiah 55:10-11).

Whenever and wherever the gospel sinks deep into good and honest hearts, it produces fruit (Luke 8:15). God made it so. We must never underestimate the power of God's Word to perform all that God intended.

Television evangelism is like the broadcasting of seed. It falls on all kinds of hearts. It will make a huge difference if it is able to penetrate the hearts. Unfortunately, some hearts are hard, some are rocky, and some are filled with weeds. There are, however, many good and honest hearts that will hear and obey.

But we must be able to get the word into their homes to get it into their hearts. Many see little reason to come to church; and if we do not get the gospel into their homes, we will fail to reach them with God's eternal truth.

This is why we need your prayers (Colossians 4:2-4) that God will open a door for the Word, so that we may speak clearly as we ought to speak.

We also urgently need your financial support. It will take us all to get the gospel out into the community and beyond the walls of our church buildings. The medium of television gets to the most people for the least cost.

SEARCH has proven for three decades its ability to reach into homes where the gospel has never gone before, homes that may not open up for a campaigner. We must use every possible means to reach the most people with the gospel. Please help us fulfill the Great Commission to a nation that needs God today more than ever!

INNOCENT OF THE BLOOD OF MEN

On his journey from Greece to Jerusalem with the money he had collected for the poor saints in Judea, the apostle Paul asked the elders of the church at Ephesus to meet him in Miletus.

Paul had preached in Ephesus about three years and had even taught in the school of Tyrannus there two years. His preaching there had caused a riot and any return would be a problem for city officials. Also, since he was in somewhat of a hurry to reach Jerusalem by Pentecost, he asked for the meeting in Miletus.

You see Paul was no stranger to those elders. The love between them was mutually strong. Paul had an important message for them, the substance of which is recorded in Acts 20:17-38. (It would be helpful if you interrupted your reading here and read that passage.) I will summarize it:

- (1) He had lived like a Christian before them.
- (2) He served the Lord with all humility,
- (3) and with many trials which happened to him by the plotting of the Jews.
- (4) In spite of all that He kept back nothing that would be helpful to them.
- (5) He taught them both publicly and from house to house.
- (6) Without hesitation, he taught them the way of salvation in Christ.

Paul's ministry in Ephesus might well serve as a model for anyone in local ministry today.

In spite of the chains and tribulations which the Holy Spirit says awaited him in Jerusalem, he said,

- (1) "None of these things move me."
- (2) "Nor do I count my life dear to myself
- (3) so that I may finish my race with joy,
- (4) and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus,
- (5) to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.....
- (6) Therefore I testify to you this day that
- (7) *I am innocent (free) from the blood of all men*
- (8) because I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God."

Why do you think Paul would preach "the gospel of God" in Ephesus, the home of the goddess of Diana?

No preacher can stand justified before God on judgment day having shunned to preach anything on which God has spoken in His word. The word of God is not a "dead letter." It is "the living and powerful"

word of God (Hebrews 4:12). It does not change and will be there to judge us in the last day.

Yes, like Paul, the price such a preacher painfully pays for declaring the whole counsel of God is exceedingly great—rejection by people thought to be friends, plotting of some brethren in the Lord, etc., but nothing when compared to what Paul and others of his day suffered. Nothing to be compared to what our fathers suffered either.

To be "free from the blood of all men" a preacher must commit himself and remain faithful to his commitment to speaking the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth with love. That is our commitment in the SEARCH program.

These will have been discontinued at the time of this printing. Discontinuance of these broadcast stations will save SEARCH close to twenty five thousand dollars each month.

Now for some good news; each of these cities has extensive cable

television networks with available time for the program. All it takes is for YOU, a cable subscriber, to get involved. And, the SEARCH staff is highly skilled and willing to take you through some simple free steps to get the program on your cable system. Don't wait; give us a call at 1-800-321-8633 and let's discuss the possibilities. In the last couple of weeks some local Christians in Wilmette, IL; Madison, WI; Marianna, FL; and Ojai, CA have called SEARCH and will soon begin the program on their local cable access stations.

Especially during these times of economic downturn and so many people are hurting across our nation, GOD is the answer we all need! Satan will not let up and he'll do all he can to silence ministries like IN SEARCH OF THE LORD'S WAY. Let's work together to ensure the Gospel of Jesus Christ is preached from sea to shining sea and beyond.
