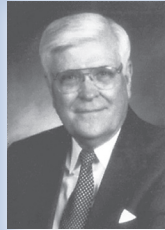

November 12th marked the 70th anniversary of my first attempt to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ. On November 15th brother L. D. McElhany and the church in Coalgate, OK where I made that first attempt, graciously permitted me to return and try again to preach. Lois and I were blessed to meet some of the children and grandchildren of some of the people present at that first event; but we met no one this time who was present on November 12, 1939.

Then on the evening of November 22nd brother Don Vinzant, the very gracious senior minister at the Edmond Church, arranged for me to preach here. He does that about once a year, some time near my birthday. His wife, Carol, and I share the same birthday (no, no, now, not the same birth date, but day).

Why have I preached 70 years, and why do I keep on preaching the gospel?

1. Older preachers. I admired them and still do. Instead of music and sports stars, preachers like Delmar Owens, C. A. Magness, C.R. Nichols, N. B. Hardeman, H. Leo Boles and others who pioneered the way were my heroes.

2. I preach because I was called of God to preach. Yes! I believe that. I believe it and I preach it; perhaps you've heard me say, "None of us came into the world because we chose or when we chose; but because God had need of us." Others are born with other gifts and talents and will give

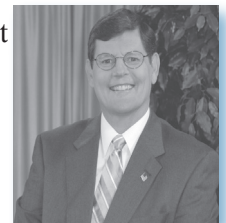

account to the Judge of all the world for how they used them. "I thank Christ Jesus our Lord who has enabled me, because He counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry" (I Tim. 1:12) and keeping me there these 70 years.

3. I couldn't (and still can't) keep from preaching the gospel of Christ (Jer. 20:7-9). "Necessity is laid upon me; yes, woe is me if I do not preach the gospel" (I Cor. 9:16). When I stand up to preach, I am not only filling a personal need, but a need of every lost or troubled soul who came to hear me.

4. I am convinced that the gospel of Christ is God's power to salvation for everyone who believes (Rom. 1:16).

5. And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard; and how shall they hear without a preacher? (Rom. 10:14-15). A recent report said 54,978,674 people died last year. Many of them never heard of Jesus Christ. Others of them never heard the truth about Him and how He saves.

A lot of things have changed in my 70 years of preaching. I rode in a horse-drawn wagon to preach that Sunday night seventy years ago. Now, I can go many, many times that distance in the same time.

We used chalk boards for visual aid; now we use power-point. We had no public address system. We shouted at the top of our voices to be heard above the crying babies and the passing traffic and railroad trains. We had no air-conditioning. We opened the windows and doors and let the bugs and flies and noise come in from the streets and alley ways. We had no padded pews. We had improvised benches with no back supports. We had no clock on the back wall under the balcony so the preacher could see when "you've preached long enough." If we had a clock, it was above and behind the preacher for the people to watch, not the preacher. We had no baptistry. We went to the rivers and creeks and farmers' ponds where we

broke the ice on the water to baptize believers.

But some things have NOT changed.

1. Man's need of the Savior is one of them. All of us have sinned. God says, "Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God" (I Cor. 6:9-10). These people and others who make bad choices in life need to hear the "gospel of God" and "of Christ" and "of salvation." They need to know there is a better way to live than all that. They need to know the way of salvation in Christ.

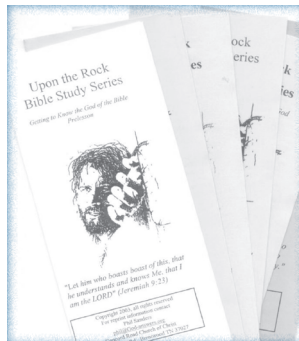
2. The church of Jesus Christ is "the pillar and support of the truth" (I Tim. 3:15).

Who will go? Who will tell them of Jesus and His love? Who will tell them they need believe in Him. Who will tell them they need to repent and be baptized for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38)? I'm being told that we in the SEARCH program are preaching to 200,000,000 to 300,000,000 such souls every week. Will you help Phil Sanders and me to keep on preaching to these people by TV, radio, satellite, the internet and the printed page? Thank you. God bless you. We love you

# SPOTLIGHT

The age of digital television is now in full implementation across the USA. Even if you are still watching on an older television using a converter box you have obviously seen the improvements. There are more stations or sub-channels to choose from, colors are brighter, picture definition and clarity are way beyond what they were only a few months ago. And, many new televisions have huge flat screens which draw our attention in a fashion similar to when television was first introduced around seventy years ago. Yes, GOD has given Christians the technology to transmit HIS word instantly into homes across this country and around the globe. We must continue to utilize every media outlet available to fulfill the Great Commission!

Of course the digital age is not without its problems. Currently television stations and networks are chasing problems and multiple complaints regarding synchronizing digital audio with digital video. Kerry Campbell, one of the SEARCH staff says, "It's similar to watching an old movie from Japan or China with English dubbed in.

The talking sound doesn't match the movement of the actors' mouths." Another issue the very technical television engineers are working on is where the picture seems to occasionally skip or pop forward about a half second or so. If you watch TV at all, you have witnessed one or both of these technical difficulties which the networks and cable companies are feverishly working to resolve. As always SEARCH intends to keep you up-to-date with issues, questions and answers received from the viewers of the program.
