
Sweet Jackie and I send our love and thanksgiving to everyone who reads this newsletter and who loves this ministry.

Change is inevitable. Last week SEARCH was notified that television station KOFY in San Francisco, CA. has been sold. And, the contract we

have had for about a dozen years, with this station, is no longer binding. I hope this is not a new trend in television broadcasting in our great country! SEARCH's longtime producer and agent, Sam Clark, started looking for a suitable replacement station in the San Francisco Bay area. As I have stated before in this newsletter,



sometimes GOD closes one door and opens another to further HIS Kingdom. Starting on April 17th station KTVU Plus TV 36.1 will begin airing IN SEARCH OF THE LORD'S WAY at 6:30 am Sunday mornings each week. This is one hour earlier than the previous station so set your DVR or back up your alarm clock for the new time. You will see the changes on the front page of this newsletter and on the schedule pages in the center section of this publication.

I talked with the SEARCH staff and asked what reminders should we be giving our newsletter readers? Almost to the person the answer was "ask our readers to remember the value of the program and to tell their friends and family to watch SEARCH." "Also, remind them to get the local time and station information in the weekly church bulletin."

One of our staff handed me the Edmond Church of Christ business card that has the address, phone number and worship times of the church. On the bottom of the card it says: "Watch IN SEARCH OF THE LORD'S WAY each Sunday morning on: KOCB-TV 34 at 7:30 am." These business cards are available to all members to take and hand to people they come in contact with. This method of advertising works very well for the local evangelistic efforts, even when shy people use them.

On the SEARCH website www.searchtv.org we maintain a free package of printable SEARCH logos and helps for all kinds of advertising venues. You will find this free download under the "Support" tab on the main menu. Remember the SEARCH program gets into homes with the Soul saving Gospel of Christ that are not reachable by other means.

From Script to Broadcast: Part 10 - The Clock is Running

As we mentioned last month everything starts and stops with the Director. Once we have everyone in position a final check is made for readiness and the command is given to "roll tape". The record button is pressed, a ten second warning is given and then a 5 second countdown to Phil's cue to speak. The clock is running.

We begin with Phil on camera 2. Throughout the program the director controls the timing and what is being recorded. In addition to 2 cameras we also have elements such as name keys, full screen billboard, songs, and scripture. Each time an element is used or a camera change is needed the Director will indicate the change to the crew and set the switcher's output so that the program is recorded properly and in order. For instance, the sequence of song, Phil and the scripture reading, Phil's prayer, the second song, Phil's sermon and finally the third song and out to black is usually done in order and without any stops. Many time cues are given by the director so that Phil and the crew will know how much time is left and we can reach the closing sequence right on time at 27 minutes and 30 seconds.

This is just a small sample of one program. Broken down piece by piece you can see there is a lot that goes into the completion of one recording. We usually do 3 in a session and then it's time for the post edit work to commence. We'll talk about that next month. See you then!
