For the time will come when people will not endure sound, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their passions, and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander off into myths" (2 Timothy 4:1-4). Paul said, "But we have disgraceful, underhanded ways. Paul wasn't interested in hiding anything or twisting his words around to anyone. He wasn't underhanded but told things like they were. You can count on what he says, and you can count on God.
To tamper with the Word of God is to distort it in order to make it say what people it to say rather than to listen to what it actually does say. When someone changes God's Word to fit their own desires, they show that they don't believe or respect God. Some falsely the Word to their agenda, and others get fooled by their deception. Such cunning to advance a distortion to God's Word is in Paul's eyes disgraceful and underhanded. Paul said that we must be ignorant of the devices that Satan uses (2 Corinthians 2:11).

It's not enough to simplify, or to simply know the truth, we must obey it as well. We obey the gospel of truth by placing our faith in Christ Jesus, repenting of our sins, by confessing the Lord Jesus as the Christ, the Son of God, and by being baptized (that is, immersed) in water for the forgiveness of our sins. It's in the faithful response of baptism that God causes us to be born again. God at that time gives us newness of life (Romans 6:4). My friend, have you obeyed the truth? Have you been born again?
