world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of"
(John 8:12). The marvelous light is life itself. This life is abundant, and it is The
Lord said to the Father, "This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and
Jesus Christ whom You have sent" (John 17:3). Our eternal life begins with knowing the only
true God and His Son Jesus Christ.
Read 1 John 2:3-6. The marvelous light shines on those who know Him, love Him, and
obey Him. Do you?
First John 1:6-7 says, "If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the
darkness, we and do not practice the truth; but if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in
the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us
from all sin." There are only two paths, one leads to life and the other leads to destruction.
Because people choose their path, they choose their God, however,
graciously gives us the opportunity to change our path and to change our relationship with Him.
We can always leave the dark path and come to the light. There's no greater blessing than to
have fellowship with God and to be cleansed from all sin by the blood of His Son.
